

Coming to Berkeley

Airports/Transportation/Shuttles

Geographically, the closest airport is Oakland International Airport (OAK), but feel free also to fly into San Francisco International Airport (SFO) which might offer more options and cheaper fares.

From both airports, you can take public transportation to the Berkeley campus. BART is the transit system that goes to both airports (direct train into SFO). <http://www.bart.gov> has more information about getting around the SF Bay Area including airports.

Accommodations

Downtown Berkeley YMCA Hotel & Residence

The rate is \$49-65 a night for a single and \$81-95 a night for a double. The YMCA is only a few blocks from campus in Downtown Berkeley and has some advantages over on-campus housing (kitchen facilities, access to the YMCA gym included). <http://ymca-cba.org/locations/downtown-berkeley-hotel>

Hotel Durant

The Hotel Durant is one block south of campus on the south side of campus, conveniently close to shops and restaurants. Cheaper rates can often be found on travel sites like Expedia, etc.
